Technology High School is located in Rohnert Park, California and is part of the Cotati-Rohnert Park Unified School District. THS is a college preparatory high school of choice focused on science, technology, engineering and math. With approximately 340 students, THS serves a broad cross-section of students in grades 9-12 who have an interest in attending an innovative, small, project-based learning program. The school holds the following distinctions: a California Distinguished School in every year of eligibility, one of the best high schools in America by the U.S. News and World Report, a Magna Award winner by the American School Board Journal, a National Blue Ribbon School awarded in 2021, and accreditation by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges.

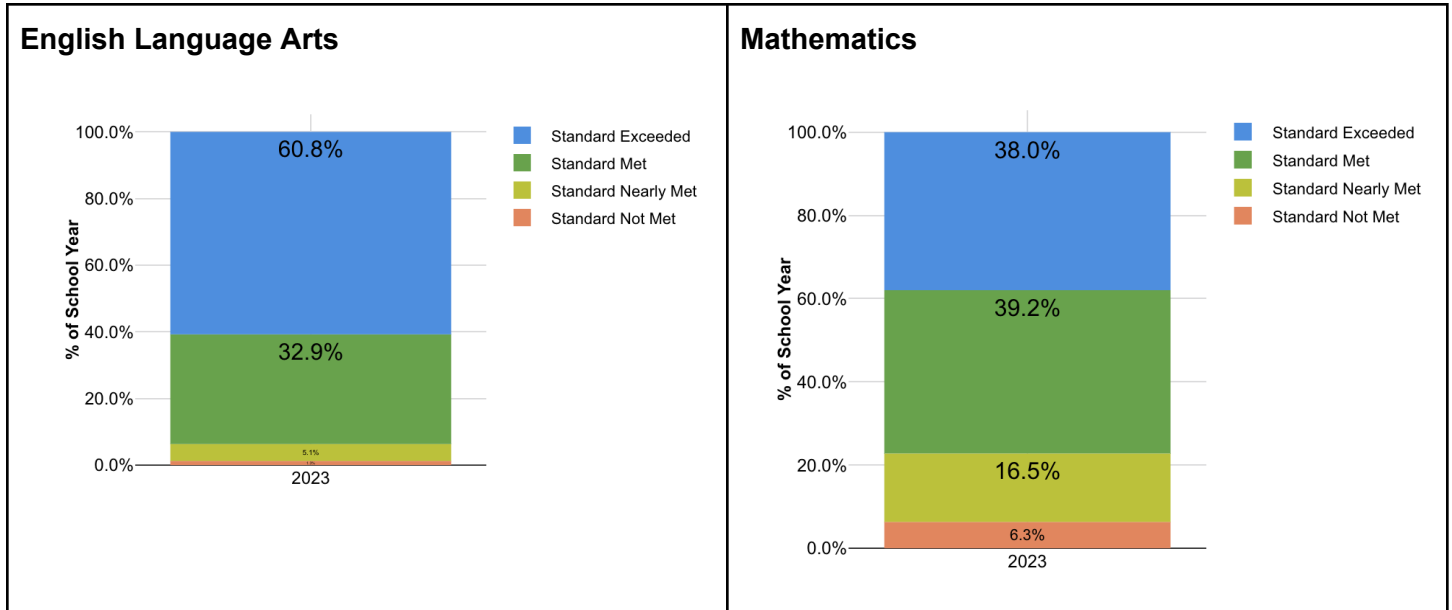
COLLEGE COURSES
